### **Minutes of Meeting**

A meeting of State Indemnity Sub Committee (21<sup>th</sup> SISC Meeting) was held on 16.07.2024 at 11.00 AM in the conference hall, 9<sup>th</sup> floor, Delhi Secretariat under the chairmanship of Mission Director, DSHM.

### The meeting was attended by following officers:

At the outset, Dr. Vandana Bagga, Director, DFW welcomed all & familiarized all with the concept and intent of Family Planning Indemnity Scheme (FPIS) & main agenda of the meeting.

### Following agenda were discussed:

## Agenda 1: Action taken on proceedings of 20th SISC meeting.

#### It was informed to all that:

- Sanction orders for State and NHM shares as per recommendations of 20<sup>th</sup> SISC have been issued for the approved cases.
- Minutes along with Reiteratory advisories on important recommendations to all districts and all accredited hospitals had been issued.
- MV Hospital has submitted minutes of meeting of repeat review on death of Geeta Devi W/o Jayram .

## Agenda 2: Scrutiny of the Twenty-One cases of Sterilization Failure reported after last meeting.

- The case summaries and submitted documents of all reported cases of failure of sterilization during the years 2022-23 (05 cases) & 2023-24 (16 cases) were presented before the committee and discussed one by one.
- The cases belonged to South, West, Central, Northwest, Shahdara & New Delhi Districts.
- The respective District Quality Committees had submitted the cases after recommendation at their level for approval of SISC.
- All cases were reviewed with respect to eligibility for claim, adherence to standards during initial (failing) procedure and management of failure.
- 16 cases of failure of Female Sterilization were cleared for payment while 03 cases were referred back to DQAC (Refer Tables 1 & 2 for recommended cases belonging to F.Y.2022-23 and 2023-24 respectively).
- 02 cases was rejected due to non-availability of sterilization certificate with claimant. In both cases, issue of certificate was not indicated due to inadequate tubal ligation.
- 01 case was deferred for want of affidavit from DISC w.r.t. identity of claimant.
- 02 cases were returned to respective DISC for submitting comments on clearing cases reporting pregnancy very late. (Presumably
- month after detection.)

While the committee allowed compensation to these three cases, it was recommended that such delay in submission of file is not acceptable and the DISCs must submit cases promptly after receiving claim from facilities. The facilities in turn must be directed by DQACs to seek & submit claim in a fast track mode.

### Following additional points were recommended by the committee:

- 1. Checklist (Annexure No. 3 to be filled properly so that documents are fool proof (Some case sheets were found to have endorsed Checklists without tick marking each point & hence the documents were not found to be upto the mark).

  Action: Nodal officers at facility & District.
- 2. For addressing missing columns in consent form & case record etc, it was recommended that regular check must be done by quality circles. 5-10% cases must be checked. **Action: MS/MD, Accredited Facilities**
- 3. Histopathology services must be available in each hospital or tie up should be done and any removed/transacted Fallopian Tubes must be subjected to histopathological examination. Further, the reports must be collected & considered at the time of issue of Certificate. Action: All Hospitals (Service delivery points)
- 4. The Committee recommended that districts must ensure timely receipt & scrutiny of reported cases of adverse events following sterilization & submit to SISC after due deliberations and logical recommendation as soon as possible. (Gross delay as seen in many cases discussed during 21<sup>st</sup> SISC is not acceptable). Similarly, forwarding of non-payable claim as per FPIS without documentation of justification in file is also to be avoided.

Issue of poor uptake of NSV was discussed among members of the committee. State NSV Surgeon Dr. Chandan Bortamuly suggested that a list of ASHAs of North and New Delhi districts may be shared with him so that ASHAs can motivate/mobilize NSV cases of their respective area. Similarly, lists of other districts may be shared with counsellors of other NSV delivery points.
