Minutes of Meeting

A meeting of State Operational Committee (MR) was conducted under the Chairpersonship of Director, DFW on **16th March 2026 at 10:00 AM** in the Conference Hall, Directorate of Family Welfare, C-Wing, 7th Floor, Vikas Bhawan-II, Delhi, to review MR Elimination strategies, along with plan for out-break response immunization in areas with confirmed/compatible cases of Measles and Rubella.

The meeting was attended by representatives from State Immunization Team, Principal, HFWTC, SPO Medical-Store, PO Procurement, IEC BCC Team, Representative from DSHM Finance, SMO (WHO), UNDP Team, State ASHA Team and State MIS Cell.

At the outset, SEPIO, Delhi gave a brief outline regarding number of Measles cases in Delhi along with 02 suspected Measles death, distribution of these cases, guidelines of MoHFW, GoI to mitigate the risk of further spread of Measles & Rubella, achievement of previous two ORIs & MR Campaign (February-March 2023) conducted in Delhi.

SMO, WHO presented a short PPT regarding current trends, surveillance status and magnitude of spread of Measles & Rubella cases in Delhi. It was also discussed that MR surveillance has taken a serious dent in Delhi in 2026 and Non-Measles, Non-Rubella (NMNR) discard rate for most of the districts has come down to less than mandatory two per lakh population.

Following directions/observations were made by the chair for further urgent necessary action:

1. All children between age of 09 months to 10 years need to be administered with an additional dose of MR vaccine (irrespective of their past immunization status) in each ASHA area population where a confirmed/compatible MR case has been reported, provided no other live vaccine have been administered within last 28 days.

(Action: DIOs)

2. All children between age of 06 months to 09 months need to be administered with an additional dose of MR vaccine (irrespective of their past immunization status) in each ASHA area population, where a confirmed/compatible MR case has been reported, provided no other live vaccine have been administered within last 28 days.

(Action: DIOs)

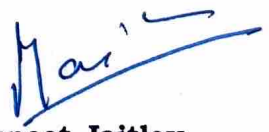
3. Surveillance measures for all VPDs to be strengthened and Districts shall ensure NMNR discard rate of more than 2 at all levels i.e. District, Assembly, Ward, & Facility level.

(Action: DSOs & DIOs)

4. Urgent review of current situation to be done under chairpersonship of respective District Magistrates and CDMOs in DTFI and DWR meetings.
(Action: DSOs & DIOs)
5. Availability of adequate vaccine doses to be ensured with each of the facility conducting out-break response immunization, so that there is no stock out of MR vaccine for ORI as well as Routine Immunization.
(Action: DIOs & DVSMs)
6. Meeting to be done with concerned MOICs, SMOs WHO and ANMs to ensure due list, organization of dedicated ORI sessions (facility and outreach) and reporting in shared google sheet, along with U-WIN Updation.
(Action: DIOs & DSOs)
7. Capacity building of concern staff (MOICs & ANMs) for timely entry of data in U-WIN and google sheet.
(Action: State MIS & UNDP Team)
8. Message regarding ORI, strengthening routine immunization and case definition of Measles & Rubella to be disseminated to all stake-holders in affected areas (RWAs, ASHAs, ICDS and parents/guardians).
(Action: State & District BCCOs)
9. Capacity building of ASHAs regarding ORI along with timelines, due-list and effective mobilization of due beneficiaries.
(Action: State & District ASHA co-ordinators)
10. Monitoring of entire activity i.e. finalization of activity areas, due lists and ORI sessions.
(Action: DIOs & WHO SMOs)

ORI activity to be initiated from 23rd March 2026 and needs to be completed by 4th April 2026, following all norms and codal formalities.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.

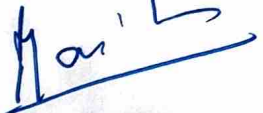
