

List of Schemes, Projects, Campaigns Completed in FY 2025-26

Adolescent Health: National De-worming Day (NDD)

De-worming is a scientifically proven method to mitigate intestinal worms and is a key intervention to curb under-nutrition and anemia.

Children and adolescents (1–19 years) are administered age-appropriate doses of chewable Albendazole tablets in Government, Government-aided, and private schools, as well as Anganwadi Centers.

In the FY 2025–26 cycle (August–September 2025), approximately 38.53 lakh children were reached, achieving 85% coverage against the target of 45 lakh.

Anaemia Mukh Bharat (AMB) Programme:

T4 Camp (Test-Treat-Talk-Track) -

3. Mild Anemia (27.32%) Moderate Anemia (22.37%) and Severe Anemia (1.16%).

Child Health:

1. Phase of Vaccination of eligible beneficiaries under Adult BCG Vaccination Study by ICMR and MoHFW, GoI is completed in NCT of Delhi in the Year 2024-25.
2. Two rounds of Pulse Polio Immunization conducted successfully as National Immunization Day (NID) on 25th August 2024, and Sub-National Immunization Day (SNID) on 8th December 2024, with more than 18 lac eligible under-5 children immunized during each round.
3. As a State Initiative, Special Immunization Campaign was conducted in four rounds, for 6 days each in Jan, Feb and March 2025 and for 10 days in April 2025 (including World Immunization Week), which aimed to boost coverage, by focusing on Left-Out, Drop-Out, Refusal and Zero-Dose cases.
4. Vaccination of Haj Pilgrims was completed through deployment of Teams from CDMO Central at Haj Manzil, Delhi.
5. Stop Diarrhoea Campaign -2025 (2 months long Campaign was celebrated in phase wise manner in Delhi State w.e.f. 2nd June – 31st July, 2025), World Breastfeeding Week 2025 (1st -7th August 2025), SAANS campaign 2025-26 (3.5 month long commencing on 12th November 2025 to 28th February 2026), National Newborn Week -2025 under Child Health, POSHAN etc. implemented successfully in Delhi in F.Y. 2025-26, these campaigns are recurring annually, along with other campaigns like

Swasth Naari Sashakt Parivar Campaign 2025.

6. Operationalization of District Early Intervention Centers (DEIC) at Chacha Nehru Bal Chikitsalya (CNBC) w.e.f. 23rd September 2025.
7. MOU for continuation of COE (Center of Excellence)-EIC (Early Intervention Center) under RBSK, NHM, between State Health Society of Delhi, Dean (MAMC) and MD (Lok Nayak Hospital) was valid upto 31st March 2026. The activity was further taken up under State budget head.
8. MOU for continuation of Mission NEEV program (Comprehensive Newborn Screening program under RBSK, NHM), in project mode in Delhi, between State Health Society of Delhi and Dean, Maulana Azad Medical College was valid upto 31st March 2026. The activity was further taken up under State budget head.
9. MOU for continuation of DEIC (District Early Intervention Center) under RBSK, NHM at Swami Dayanand Hospital, between State Health Society of Delhi and Director Hospital Administration, Municipal Corporation of Delhi, was valid upto 31st March 2026. The NHM initiative has been shifted from project to program mode. No further MOU extension is required.
10. Various other Schemes/Projects/Programmes/Central Acts being implemented by this Directorate are on-going in nature.

Family Planning:

World Population Day 2025 (27-June-2025 to 24-July-2025) & Vasectomy Fortnight 2025 (21-November-2025 to 04-December 2025) were celebrated successfully in Delhi for F.Y. 2025-26, these celebration/campaigns are recurring annually.

Immunization:

1. Two rounds of Pulse Polio Immunization conducted successfully as National Immunization Day (NID) on 25th August 2024, and Sub-National Immunization Day (SNID) on 8th December 2024, with more than 18 lac eligible under-5 children immunized during each round.
2. One round of Pulse Polio Immunization conducted successfully as Sub-National Immunization Day (SNID) on 12th October 2025, with more than 17.7 lac eligible under-5 children immunized during the round.
3. As a State Initiative, six rounds of Special Immunization Campaign were conducted in F.Y. 2025-26, which aimed to boost coverage, by focusing on Left-Out, Drop-Out, Refusal and Zero-Doser cases, with details as under:
20th to 30th April 2025 [World Immunization Week]
25th to 30th August 2025
22nd to 27th September 2025
10th to 15th November 2025 (Mop-Up)
19th to 24th January 2026
16th to 21st February 2026
4. Vaccination of Haj Pilgrims, with SIV and QMMV vaccines were ensured for all eligible HAJ Pilgrims at 03 different sites in Delhi (first time) i.e. LOK NAYAK HOSPITAL, GTB HOSPITAL and Pt. MADAN MOHAN MALVIYA HOSPITAL, besides posting, coordinating and monitoring of staff at HAJ Manzil. More than 3000 Haj Pilgrims were timely vaccinated during the drive.
5. Stop Diarrhoea Campaign -2024 (2 month long commencing on 1st July 2024 to 31st July 2024), World Breastfeeding Week 2024, SAANS campaign 2024-25 (3.5 month long commencing on 12th November 2024 to 28th February 2025), National Newborn Week -2024 under Child Health along with other campaigns like World Health Day etc. implemented successfully in Delhi in F.Y. 2024-25, these campaigns are recurring annually. In pursual of proposal to start safe transport services for sick newborns in Delhi, the services/ provision of 11 Neonatal transport CATS ambulance were made available in October 2024 with the logistics support from Dept. of CATS ambulance.
6. Various other Schemes/ Projects/ Programmes/ Central Acts being implemented by this Directorate are on-going in nature.

1. Celebration of National Girl Child (Beti Utsav) Day on 24th January 2026;
2. Beti Shakti Abhiyan from 18th to 31st January & every year on 24th January.
